

Ambassador of Turkmenistan Attended the Inauguration Ceremonies of the President of Portugal

On March 9, the inauguration ceremonies of the newly elected President of the Portuguese Republic, António José Seguro, were held at the Assembly of the Republic building in Lisbon.
